SCHOOL BOND ELECTION KEARNEY COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT 0503 (MINDEN PUBLIC SCHOOLS) IN THE STATE OF NEBRASKA	
“Shall Kearney County School District 0503 (Minden Public Schools) in the State of Nebraska (the “District”) issue general obligation bonds of the District in an aggregate stated principal amount not to exceed Twenty-three Million One Hundred Five Thousand Dollars (\$23,105,000), for the purpose of paying the costs of purchasing land, site preparation, constructing a new high school building, constructing additions and improvements to the existing middle school and elementary school buildings, and providing the necessary furniture, equipment, and apparatus for such school buildings; such bonds to be issued from time to time as may be determined by the Board of Education, to bear interest at a rate or rates to be determined by the Board of Education and to become due at such time or times as may be fixed by the Board of Education; and	
“Shall the District cause to be levied and collected annually a special levy of taxes against all the taxable property in the District sufficient in rate and amount to pay the principal of and interest on such bonds as the same become due?”

CITY OF MINDEN
PROPOSAL TO INCREASE LOCAL SALES AND
USE TAX RATE

Shall the governing body of the incorporated municipality - the City of Minden – increase the local sales and use tax rate by an additional one percent (1%) from the current rate of one percent (1%) to a rate of two percent (2%) and impose a sales and use tax at the increased rate upon the same transactions within such municipality on which the State of Nebraska is authorized to impose a tax, with at least 50% of the revenues generated by the additional one percent (1%) to be used for public infrastructure projects including, without limitation, water system improvements within City Limits?

A "Yes" Vote: If a majority of the votes cast upon such question shall be in favor of increasing such local sales and use tax rate by an additional one percent (1%), then the governing body of such incorporated municipality - the City of Minden - shall be empowered as provided by Section 77-27,142 of the Nebraska Statutes and shall forthwith proceed to increase the local sales and use tax rate from one percent (1%) to two percent (2%) and impose a sales and use tax at the increased rate pursuant to the Local Option Revenue Act, with at least 50% of the revenues generated by the additional one percent (1%) to be used for public infrastructure projects including, without limitation, water system improvements within City Limits.

A "No" Vote: If a majority of those voting on the question shall be opposed to such an increase of the local sales and use tax rate by an additional one percent (1%), then the governing body of the incorporated municipality shall not impose such a tax increase and the local sales and use tax rate will remain unchanged at one percent (1%).

Additional Information Regarding Proposed Local Sales and Use Tax Rate Increase

Projects to be funded; savings, efficiencies and affect on other taxes or fees: Of the additional revenues collected from increasing the sales and use tax rate by one percent (1%) at least fifty percent (50%) will be used to fund in whole or in part and pay costs of public infrastructure projects, including, without limitation, water system improvements, as defined in Nebraska Statutes, Section 77-27, 142, within City Limits, that otherwise would be funded or payable from other taxes, fees or revenues, including without limitation, property, occupation, or sales and use taxes.

Years revenue collected; payment of bonds: The increased sales and use tax rate will be implemented and related revenues collected beginning as soon as practicable after voter approval with one half percent (1/2%) of the proposed one percent (1%) increase having no declared termination date. The remaining one half percent (1/2%) will continue for a period of ten years unless bonds are issued with some or all of the additional revenues pledged for payment of such bonds in which case the increased sales and use tax rate will remain in effect and additional revenues will be collected until payment in full of such bonds and any refunding bonds.

Interlocal Agreement. The City of Minden and the Minden Consolidated Rural Fire District entered an interlocal agreement for the long term development of unified governance of public infrastructure projects, specifically as relating to the cooperative use of public buildings, capital equipment to provide fire department and emergency medical services for the joint and mutual benefit and protection of said Cities and District, and to review City water system improvements and upgrades to ensure that such infrastructure improvements provide adequate fire flow protection to the community. Of the additional revenues collected from increasing the sales and use tax rate by one percent (1%) at least fifty percent (50%) will be used to fund in whole or in part and pay costs of public infrastructure projects, including, without limitation, water system improvements, and none (0%) will be used for purposes of the interlocal agreement.
