



REGULAR MEETING BOARD OF SUPERVISORS KEARNEY COUNTY, NEBRASKA February 8, 2011 – 9:30 A.M.

A Regular Meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Kearney County, NE was held February 8, 2011 at 9:30 a.m. in the Supervisors' Room of the Courthouse in Minden, NE, Present were Chairman Richard A. Schwenka and Board Members Dick McBride, David McCroden, Roy John Nelson, William F. Pittner and Robert Swanson. Absent was Jean Rush. Also present were County Clerk Myra Johnson, Highway Superintendent Randall Smith, and Misty DeLashmutt Editor of the Minden Courier

The Board of Supervisors took the following action:

- -Approved the County Clerk and Clerk of the District Court Fee Reports for January, 2011.
- -Approved the Minutes from the Board of Supervisors meeting held January 18, 2011.
- -Approve Bills & Claims (see below)
- -Denied the claim for \$1,750.00 from O'Brien Straatmann Funeral Home for services.
- -February is 4-H month. Kaelyse Clapper, a senior at Minden High School and BethAnn Wackerla a junior at Axtell Schools gave an update on 4-H projects. 96% of the youth involved in 4-H learn skills they will use in their jobs. 95% of the youth involved in 4-H go on to higher education. Some of the 4-H projects include teaching life skills like sewing and cooking, speech helps to communicate in the workplace and projects that are done can go into the business field.
- -Reviewed the Veteran Service Officer quarterly report ending in 12-31-2010. Also reviewed the County Treasurer Semi Annual Report ending 12-31-2010.
- -Met with some of the members of the Kearney County Historical Society. Linda Ard, Mary Lou Kristensen, Bill Petersen, Dena Beck and Annie Jacobsen. They presented the Board with a copy of the Kearney County Self guided tour map for their support of the project. It took 18 months and a committee of 8 people to complete. They can be purchased at Pedley Drug, Minden Opera House, McBride Realty, Burchells Whitehill Farmhouse, Ft. Kearny, Rowe Sanctuary, Axtell Bank, Wilcox Ins. Co., Jane Kuehns Quilt Shop for \$4.00 each or 25 for \$75.00.
- -Met with Tom Pillen and Mark Miller from NPPD to give an update of the transmission line. All the engineering is done. There have been 24 easements signed in Kearney County. The easements are paying 80% of the appraised property value which is approx. \$5,000 an acre for irrigated ground. Each pole set is running about \$2,500. It is costing NPPD about \$90,000 per mile for right-a-way. Poles are set 35 to 50 feet deep. The lines are running mostly on the ½ mile line. Steel pole contracts will go out in May, Construction Contracts in August, Tree clearing in April and starting construction in October.
- -Met with Randall Smith, Highway Supt. concerning road matters.
- -Opened gravel bids for 2011. Broadfoot Sand & Gravel Inc. Kearney or Minden pit -Bidders Loader \$4.40 or County Loader \$4.05, Mid-Nebraska Aggregates Bidders loader \$4.44, Ed Broadfoot & Sons Bidder's Loader \$6.25, T & F Gravel Bidder's Loader \$6.14. Gravel bids are good through December 31, 2011. Motion was approved to accept all bids.
- -Neleigh Korth has accepted the position of Deputy County Attorney starting March 1, 2011. She will be working into the County Attorney position no later than July 1, 2011. The County Attorney office will be moved into the Kearney County Courthouse on the first floor by April 1, 2011. Discussion was held as to office equipment and moving existing offices.
- -Adjourned the Board of Supervisors meeting at 11:40 a.m.
