A Regular Meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Kearney County, NE was held February 5, 2013 at 9:30 a.m. in the Supervisors' Room of the Courthouse in Minden, NE, Present were Chairman Richard A. Schwenka and Board Members Dick McBride, Larry Landstrom, Roy John Nelson, William F. Pittner, Robert Swanson and Ross Bruning. Also present were County Clerk Myra Johnson, Melodie Bellamy County Attorney, Highway Supt. Randall Smith, Joe Anderson Zoning Admin. and Jim Edgecombe Editor of the Minden Courier.

The Board of Supervisors took the following action:

-Approved the County Clerk and Clerk of the District Court Fee Reports for January, 2013.

-Approved the Minutes from the Board of Supervisors meeting held January 15, 2013.

-Approve Bills & Claims

-Reviewed the County Veteran Service Officers quarterly report ending December 2012 and the County Treasurer Semi-annual report ending December, 2012.

-Approved the changes in Pledged Securities for the County Clerk. \$500,000.00 was release from Wells Fargo Bank NA and \$500,000.00 was added from Federal Home Loan Bank by the Minden Exchange Bank & Trust Co.

-Approved the Memorandum of Understanding between the South Central PET Region and Kearney County for tower space at 246 N. Colorado Ave., Minden, NE.

-Held a Public Hearing from 9:30 to 9:40 a.m. on Zoning Regulations for Adult Entertainment in Kearney County. There were no written comments and no one appeared for or against the changes. The Zoning regulations that were submitted by the Planning and Zoning Commission were approved with the addition of parking spaces.

-Discussed bid letting for security devices in the Courthouse and at the Road Dept. with Joe Anderson, Safety Comm. Chm. It was suggested by the Board to get some estimates and specifications from vendors and then decide which equipment the County would need and go from there. Also discussed Assembly Room use policy. Whether to charge rent for the room and who is responsible with keys to open and close the building. At this time, it was decided to not charge rent and to have the Safety Committee revise the use policy and bring it back to the Board for approval.

-Approved an Administrative Subdivision for David and Becky Grimes for a 7.19 acres tract in the NE1/4 NE1/4 of 21-6-14.

-Met with Randy Smith, Highway Supt. concerning pavement preservation. He will be getting specifications for armor coating. Set date for gravel bids for March 5, 2013 at 10:00 a.m.

-Rhonda Herrick Extension Educator talked on February being Nebraska 4H month. She also thanked the Board for their participation in County Government Day. Ben Alberts reported that he has been in 4H for 10 years raising cows, sheep and goats and would like to become a farmer. Madison Ayres reported that she has been in 4H for approx. 10 years involved in clothing, sewing and cooking, while learning life and leadership skills like nutrition and exercise. They are both fundraising for a trip to Washington DC to learn about citizenship and government.

-Received correspondence from RYDE Transit showing the proposed rate increases for Kearney County. \$1.50 per boarding one way in Minden, \$5.00 per boarding one way on outside trips within the county, \$12.00 per boarding one way on a trip from Minden to a location outside of the County. RYDE Transit will be holding a public hearing so that any individual may voice a concern about the new rate structure.
